WELCOME TO THE ITV ACADEMY NEWS TRAINEESHIP FOR 2025-6

The ITV Academy News Traineeship is providing trainee journalist opportunities for those who are looking to start their career in News and is particularly keen to receive applications from those who are from Black, Asian and minority ethnic backgrounds, disabled people and those from lower socio economic groups as we recognise that individuals from these groups are currently underrepresented in our industry.

Candidates will receive a salary of £29,034 per annum (£21,776 over 9 months) and five weeks paid annual leave pro-rata during the scheme, plus public holidays.

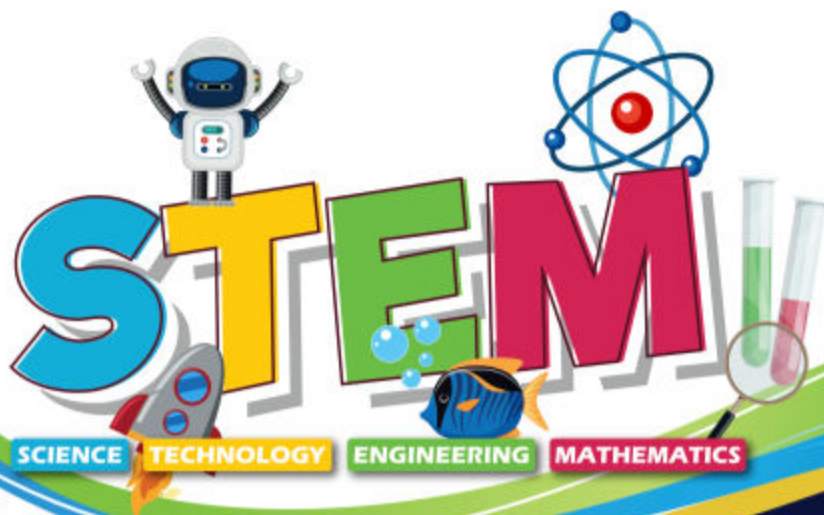
