

Uniform	Items in bold can only be purchased from Brenda's, the official school supplier Other items can be purchased at a retailer of your choice
Blazer	Indigo blue blazer with school logo The blazer must be worn at all times unless a member of staff gives permission to remove it
Shirt	White shirt, long or short sleeved Tucked in and fastened at the collar
Tie	Tie in House colour
Jumper	Black V neck jumper (optional) <i>Historic uniform - grey jumper Years 8 to 11 only until July 2025</i>
Trousers	Black trousers, smart and 'suit-style' conservatively fitted (not tight, leggings or stretch fabric) and no denim, chinos or cord Belts must be plain black with a plain buckle
Skirt	Black stitch down pleated skirt (all round pleats), knee length (Can be purchased elsewhere but use the Brenda's skirt as a guide)
Tights	Plain black or neutral
Socks	Plain black socks
Shoes	Black, low heeled, leather type, polishable Not permitted - trainers, Nike Air Force One and Converse/Vans-style plimsolls or canvas shoes
Outside Coats and bags	An outdoor coat suitable for inclement weather can be worn over the blazer and must be removed for lessons Logos must be discreet. Hoodies, denim jackets or casual sports jackets are not permitted A school bag is essential, logos to be discreet
Make-up	Make-up should be natural, discreet and barely noticeable False eyelashes of any description are not permitted Clear nail varnish only is acceptable. False/acrylic/gel nails are not permitted Tattoos are not permitted in accordance with the Tattooing of Minors Act 1969.
Hair	Hair has to be tied off the shoulders when required for safety reasons Extreme styles, eg shaving the head or tramlines, non-natural colours are not permitted Hair accessories must be black Hijabs must be black or navy
Jewellery	An inexpensive watch, one necklace and one small stud in each ear lobe are accepted Additional earrings and other body piercings are not permitted No responsibility is accepted for jewellery which is lost or stolen and all jewellery is forbidden to be worn during PE. The taping of earrings or other piercings is not permitted
Phones & Equipment	Mobile phones are prohibited at Bohunt Farnborough. Please see the Behaviour Policy for further details.

PE Kit	Students must ensure they bring their PE kit to school on the correct day <i>If students are excused from PE they must provide a note of excusal and are still required to get changed into their PE kit so they can take an active part in the lesson through a coaching or officiating role</i>
Polo Shirt	Sports Polo shirt with school logo, black and white (GCSE PE only) Sports polo top with logo, blue and white
Shorts	Plain black football style or black skort
Socks	Black, knee high, football style for winter White, ankle socks for summer
Shoes	Sports trainers Football boots (KS3)
Optional	¾ zip mid-layer sports top with school logo, long sleeved Track trousers Sports leggings, plain black, full length (not thin material or cycling shorts)
Equipment	Shin pads (KS3)

We recommend that all uniform items are labelled with your child's name.
