Series of technique and media focused workshops with a focus on the use of the Formal Elements and principles of design.

Year 9 – Foundation year to enrich skills, knowledge and experiences, equipping them for the GCSE years ahead.

Students study the work and life of Francis Bacon, understanding how life can impact an artists work. They learn how photography can be used to develop a painted response.
