Uniform September 2026

We continue to place great importance on students arriving each day ready to learn, confident, and looking smart. Our uniform plays a key role in this: it reflects our high expectations, strengthens our shared identity, and helps every young person feel part of a positive, ambitious community. We will be upholding these expectations consistently, and families will be contacted where uniform does not meet the required standard, in line with our Behaviour Policy.

Please take a moment to review our full uniform expectations. Items in blue must be purchased from Brenda's Schoolwear, our official supplier, while all other items may be bought from any retailer as long as they meet the stated specifications. Thank you for your continued support in ensuring our students present themselves with pride and are fully equipped for success each day.

School Uniform

- **Blazer:** Indigo blue blazer with school logo
Must be worn at all times unless permission is given by a member of staff
- **Shirt:** White, long or short sleeved
Must be tucked in and fastened at the collar
- **Tie:** In House colour
- **Jumper:** Black V-neck (optional)
- **Trousers:** Black, smart and 'suit-style' conservatively fitted.
Not tight, leggings or stretch fabric – and no denim, chinos, cords or flares.
- **Skirt:** Black stitch-down pleated skirt (all round pleats) (knee length)
May be purchased elsewhere but must match Brenda's style
- **Tights:** Plain black or neutral
- **Socks:** Plain black
- **Shoes:** Black, low-heeled, leather-type, polishable
Trainers, Nike Air Force One, Converse, Vans-style or canvas shoes are not permitted
- **Coats & Bags:** Outdoor coats (discreet logos only) worn over blazers and removed for lessons
No hoodies, denim or casual sports jackets permitted. A suitable school bag with discreet logo is essential

Trousers (Boys): Black, smart and 'suit-style' conservatively fitted.



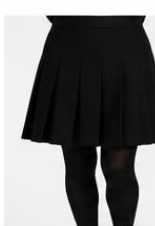
Not tight, leggings or stretch fabric – and no denim, chinos, cords or flares.

Tights: Plain black or neutral



Socks: Plain black



Shoes: Black, low-heeled, leather-type, polishable



Trainers, Nike Air Force One, Converse, Vans-style or canvas shoes are not permitted

PE Kit Expectations

Students must bring their PE kit on their allocated PE days.

If excused from physical activity, students must still bring and change into their PE kit in order to take part in the lesson in a coaching or officiating role.

- **Polo Shirt:**
 - *KS3–KS4 core PE:* Sports polo shirt with school logo (black and white)
 - *GCSE PE only:* Sports polo top with logo (blue and white)
- **Shorts/Skort:** Plain black football-style shorts or black skort
- **Socks:**
 - Black, knee-high football socks (winter)
 - White, ankle socks (summer)
- **Shoes:** Sports trainers
- **Football Boots:** Required for KS3
- **Optional items:**
 - **¾ zip mid-layer sports top** with school logo
 - Track trousers
 - Plain black, full-length sports leggings (not thin material or cycling shorts)
- **Equipment:** Shin pads (KS3)

Appearance & Personal Presentation

- **Make-up:** Must be discreet and barely noticeable
 - No false eyelashes or acrylic/gel nails. Clear nail varnish only.
- **Hair:** No extreme styles (e.g. shaved patterns, unnatural colours)
 - Hair must be tied back for safety where required. Accessories must be black.
 - Hijabs: Black or navy only.
- **Jewellery:** One watch, one necklace, and one small stud per ear lobe permitted
 - No additional piercings. All jewellery must be removed for PE. Taping is not permitted.
 - School is not responsible for lost/stolen jewellery.
- **Mobile Phones** are a prohibited item at Bohunt Farnborough. If a student brings a mobile phone to school, it must be handed in at Morning Greeting and will be locked away securely until afterschool. If a student is found in possession of a mobile phone during the school day, they will be sanctioned in line with our Behaviour Policy.

Everyday Equipment

Students are expected to arrive at school each day with the equipment they need for learning. Every student should bring:

- Black or blue pen
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Highlighters
- Scientific calculator – CASIO fx-85GTCW+ Scientific Calculator (Black)

Having the correct equipment helps students to be fully prepared for every lesson and supports their learning throughout the school day.
